## Information Sheet

**Where:** Camp Kon-O-Kwee  
126 Nagel Road  
Fombell, PA 16123-1116

**What to bring:** Please consider bringing snacks and soft drinks for Friday evening and Saturday afternoon and indicate on your response form what you would like to bring. We do have good access to a refrigerator and microwave.

Camp Kon-O-Kwee provides pillows, sheets, blankets and towels. You do not have to bring your own unless you are particular about these things.

**Food:** All food served at Shabbaton is either fish or dairy. If you have any special food requirements (allergies, etc.) please call the Temple Sinai office to make sure we have something for everyone.

**Directions:** Take I-279 North, which will turn into I-79 North  
Get off at exit #83 (Evans City).  
Bear right off the exit to light (you will cross over I-79)  
Turn left at the light.  
Go approximately 2/10 of a mile to Rt. 19 N and then right toward Zelienople.  
Turn left at 2<sup>nd</sup> light (Hotel Kaufman) onto State Route 288  
Continue 5 miles from Zelienople. You will cross railroad tracks and a bridge.  
Right after the bridge, bear left at the Y onto 588  
Continue on to camp (on your right) The entrance is across from Duffy's Countryside.

**Emergency Info:** The phone system at the camp has an emergency extension. When the office is closed, the voice recording says that if the call is an emergency, **press 9**. The person making the emergency call then records their message. From there, the phone system dials both the Assistant Camp Director and the Camp Director on their cell phones every four minutes until they answer.

Most cell phones will work around camp.
